For more than 25 years, we have proudly helped older Western Australians access the right supports, information and protections available to them.



What does a community visitor do?

Our volunteers provide companionship to older people through one-to-one visits to their home or residential aged care facility.

They can choose to spend their time together in many ways:

- Enjoying a chat over a cuppa
- ✓ Working on a hobby or activity together
- ✓ Taking a walk in the garden
- Reading or listening to music
- Connecting with the community for example, visiting a café, an exhibition or the park.



Who would I visit, how often and when?

Advocare volunteers visit older people living in the Perth metropolitan area or, in regions across the South West, who:

- ✓ live in their own home and receive/are waiting for a Home Care Package
- are residents in an aged care facility.

We try to match volunteers with older people based on shared interests and proximity to your home.

All visits are face to face and scheduled between 8:00am and 7:00pm Monday to Friday, and between 10.00am and 3:00pm on weekends.

Volunteers visit once fortnightly at a minimum, however we encourage weekly visits to strengthen relationships.
