WA Elder Abuse Helpline

or someone you know is suffering from elder abuse and not sure what to do?

The Elder Abuse Helpline is a free and confidential phone service for people to seek initial support about elder abuse.

Advocates can provide information to assist with identifying elder abuse and can then explore what the next steps might look like.

Do note this is not a reporting line. The older person is responsible for making a report to the police.
